Enable badword filtering in fireboard

Modify components/com_fireboard/template/default/post.php

Look for the following:

```
if ($fbConfig)
{
$badwords = Badword::filter($fb_message_txt, $my);
if ($badwords == "true") {
$fb_message_txt = _COM_A_BADWORDS_NOTICE;
}
}
```

Replace by:

```
if ($fbConfig)
{
require_once( 'components/com_badword/class.badword.php' );
$badwords = Badword::filter($fb_message_txt, $my);
if ($badwords == "true") {
$fb_message_txt = _COM_A_BADWORDS_NOTICE;
}
}
```

This fixes the Undefined class name 'badword' error when replying a post.

Works for me.
