Try this:

Edit the file /components/com_fireboard/templates/default/plugins/recentposts/recentposts.php

Al line 178, change this:

```
$link = sefRelToAbs("index.php?option=com_fireboard&func=view&id=$row->fbid" . "&catid=$row->catid#$row->fbid" . "&#x27;);
```

for this:

```
$link = sefRelToAbs("index.php?option=com_fireboard" . FB_FB_ITEMID_SUFFIX . "&func=view&id=$row->fbid" . "&catid=$row->catid#$row->fbid" . "&#x27;);
```

Respect to the stats, edit first the file /components/com_fireboard/templates/default/plugins/stats/stats.php

Go to the line 30, and change this:

```
$profilelink = 'index.php?option=com_fireboard&func=fbprofile&task=showprf&userid=';
```

for this:

```
$profilelink = 'index.php?option=com_fireboard' . FB_FB_ITEMID_SUFFIX . '&func=fbprofile&task=showprf&userid=';
```

And finally, go to the file /components/com_fireboard/templates/default/plugins/stats/frontstats.php

At line 24, change this:

```
$userlist = sefRelToAbs('index.php?option=com_fireboard&func=userlist');
```

for this:

```
$userlist = sefRelToAbs('index.php?option=com_fireboard'. FB_FB_ITEMID_SUFFIX . '&func=userlist');
```

At line 44 change this:

```
$statslink = sefRelToAbs('index.php?option=com_fireboard&func=stats');
```

for this:

```
$statslink = sefRelToAbs('index.php?option=com_fireboard'. FB_FB_ITEMID_SUFFIX . '&func=stats');
```

At line 49, change also this:

```
$userlist = sefRelToAbs('index.php?option=com_fireboard&func=userlist');
```

for this:

```
$userlist = sefRelToAbs('index.php?option=com_fireboard'. FB_FB_ITEMID_SUFFIX . '&func=userlist');
```

... and at line 91, change this:

```
echo sefRelToAbs('index.php?option=com_fireboard&func=latest');
```

for this:

```
echo sefRelToAbs('index.php?option=com_fireboard'. FB_FB_ITEMID_SUFFIX . '&func=latest');
```

This works OK for me ;)

Ok...figured out what the "problem" is.

You are using mod_rewrite on your webspace.
That means: your apache manipulates the html links above in the adress-strip.

One example:

This is your board login:
http://www.***.com/component/option,com_login/Itemid,50/

This is my board login:
http://***.de/index.php?option=com_login&Itemid=41

My link is generated other than yours because i don't use mod_rewrite.
Your way has some advantages: not everybody can see that you use php for your site and use mysql-injections to hack your site.
And this is the thing why my edited files doesn't work on your site...

Are you hosting your site from your homepc or with a webspace-host?
