Although you uninstalled the files for Fireboard using the Joomla Admin Panel, often times remnants get left behind. You need to go into the Server via FTP and go to Administrator/Components and ensure com_fireboard does not exist as well as in the Components folder.

After doing both of these ensure that you have successfully dropped all FB Tables in your SQL DB.

Also, I noticed a mention of Languages.. what language are you attempting to use if not English?

looks like someone only tested the release with error_reporting set quite low so it didn't show NOTICE errors...

I had a short look into the files, and for some of the variables notices were shown in my installation, e.g. msg_skype:
Am I right that it should get defined in view.php and then displayed by message.php? the only place in view.php where msg_skype gets defined is in line 964 after the following condition:

```
if ($userinfo->SKYPE != "") {
```

so if that doesn't apply, the variable is not set tuhs resulting in the NOTICE
(I don't know the condition's details though so I can only guess that there is a circumstance where this happens)

I also had a look into \$msg_avatar which wasn't set in my case. It should get loaded from the CB profile but in the responsible lines 543ff. Let's have a look at lines 552ff

```
$database->setQuery("SELECT avatar FROM #__comprofiler WHERE user_id='$fmessage->userid' AND
avatarapproved='1'");
$avatar = $database->loadResult();
```

```
if ($avatar != "")
```

what if the DB query is unsuccessful (avatar not approved or the user simply does not have one)? is \$avatar empty then? I guess so, and that is why the variable is unset.

Looks like there is no clean and quick fix to this since although you might change

```
if ($msg_skype) {
    echo $msg_skype;
}
```

in messages.php, ll 119-121 and similar variables to:

```
if (!empty($msg_skype)) {
    echo $msg_skype;
}
```

I'll probably wait for a new release because it looks like there are several variables and the 1500 lines large view.php which doesn't that developer friendly either, does not really motivate me to search for undefined variables...

My site is running on my dedicated server. Just for testing purposes on one of my other domains I installed a fresh copy of Joomla than CB and than Fireboard all of which are the latest stable versions. This test site works perfectly well – no problem whatsoever. This make me think, is there perhaps another component/module I installed causing a conflict with Fireboard?

Back to my original site, just noticed that looking at a post as a guest there are no error messages at all and only after logging in the errors are coming up.

Not necessarily...

First of all, the error_reporting level should include NOTICES (but I guess this is the case with your test instalation). Second it might depend on the users... Take the \$msg_avatar notice for example: I've got users with NULL entries in the avatar column of the CB table - this is probably returned that way by joomla when requesting the result of the DB query and this is why \$msg_avatar is never set - so once you have a message of such a user in your forum and let FB load avatars from CB you MUST have this NOTICE (from my level of understanding)

Understand what you are saying. I tried setting some values for skype, gender, icq and so on and the errors disappear. Deleting these values gain in the profile make the errors return. This sort of confirms your theory. Still, it's strange that everything is working on a different domain on the same server.

- Upload to Joomla admin page :

2) Installing Community Builder :

- Download cb_1_1_0-unzip1st.zip
- Unzip locally, got file :
com_comprofiler.zip, mod_cblogin.zip, mod_comprofilerModerator.zip,
mod_comprofilerOnline.zip
- upload to Joomla admin page :
Installer -> Component -> upload file 'com_comprofiler.zip'
click Upload & Install

Installer -> Modules -> upload file 'mod_comprofilerModerator.zip'
click Upload & Install

Installer -> Modules -> upload file 'mod_cblogin.zip'
click Upload & Install

Installer -> Modules -> upload file 'mod_comprofilerOnline.zip'
click Upload & Install

3) Installing CB Plugin for Fireboard :

- Download cb.fireboard_1_1.zip
- upload to Joomla admin page :
Components -> Community Builder -> Plugin Management
upload file 'cb.fireboard_1_1.zip'
click Upload & Install
- Click Publish for this plugin (CB Fireboard Plugin)

4) Configure Fireboard :

Components -> Fireboard Forum -> Fireboard Configuration
Edit name, email, template etc ...
Click SAVE

Create Forum Category :

Components -> Fireboard Forum -> Forum Administration -> New
Insert/edit the form ...
Click SAVE

5) Publish to MainMenu (Joomla) :

Menu -> MeinMenu -> New
choose : Components -> Component -> Next
Insert Name, access type, published, etc ...
Click SAVE

6) From user front end of Joomla, there is a link (button), if we click
show Error :

"There are no Categories define yet" :(

I ran into this same issue (PHP Notices all over FB) this evening. While I don't know the cause, I have a workable solution. I've created a simple bot that will set the error reporting level to exclude notices. It's worked on my test site...

Install the bot then be sure to publish it and make it *LAST* in the bot ordering. It should reset the error reporting level and you should be good to go. Like I said, this isn't a long-term solution but it should ease the pressure.
