I've just started using Tortoise SVN client for another component and it works well for me.

I want a forum, like the look of FireBoard, but see lots of complaints here about 'bugs'. I guess there are going to be lots of issues with \*so many\* users with different configurations and upgrades. A bit of a nightmare.

My situation is simpler. It will be a fresh install of FB version 1.0.3

My questions are:

Should I use the 1.0.3 release or the SVN?

How do I access SVN?

Is there a changes notification mailing list or .. ?

Are changes being made to the database or just the code?

Notes:

I do have \*some\* time to investigate bugs

It's \*not\* 'mission critical'

I would like to use existing modules with it if possible

Any info appreciated.
