I can't have the background dark for the whole site. but if it was a little darker in the forum it would hurt. I have to edit the orange a bit to get a little bit to make them a bit brigher. The menu bars on the main site are going to get a little darker to not be soo bright. I want to get them a little closer to the Harley Davidson color scheme.

What would it take to get the footer in the forum removed? Not my company logo at the bottom. I just noticed what was different - my footer from the main template went away with that code. I have changed the code back to reflect my company. :)
