Hi guys,  
I had this problem too, the one with An Error Has Occurred! Unable to open config file to write! huh :huh: finally after a few hours search, I found the solution, it is a require\_once problem.

in file admin.badwords2.php at line 25 there is a require\_once('settings.badwords2.perm.php');  
This file contains the variables regarding the config files for badwords, badregexp, etc.  
in the functions editBwRow(), saveBwRow(), showBwData(), removeBwData() comment out the line global \$bw\_file\_badwords, \$bw\_file\_admins, \$bw\_file\_regexp;, in each of this functions and add require\_once('settings.badwords2.perm.php');  
This worked for me. Now I see the list of the badwords, I can Edit and Save.
