Okay - figured it out. The answer was sitting in a question in this forum from a while back. I went back to try to find the post so I could link to it, but couldn't find it. I'll explain what I did...

All you have to do is, within your Joomla! user menu (once you're logged in) go to Menu > menu manager > click on the "edit" icon for what ever menu item you need. Then, you'll see all you menu items. Add a new menu item by clicking the icon in the top right. Now, select "component" from this list...and on the next screen you'll be able to indicate you want the FireBoard component on that page.

Hope this helps someone!
