Hmmm... a forum is supposed to be an archive of info, not only a place where to ask.

After my post I saw that some code was stripped out, so I immediately replied explaining what to do:

Well, I simply removed l_ from the name of the image, so what is being called is the original image not the resized one.

Explaining: since resizing an animated gif doesn't 'produce' a new animated gif resized (but a 'static' one), I simply modified that piece of code making sure that the image to display is not the resized one but the original one. And this can be achieved simply removing l_ from the name of the image.

The only drawback is the possibility to have problems with dimensions.

But I don't understand your solution. I Use FB 1.0.5. and the code looks like from 107-123:

So only take rid of just 1 I_

I dunno what else to say, but my version is 1.0.4

You said nothing changed, so if you look at properties of your image, which is the filename?

If it still has I_ in front, I believe there are only 2 possibilities:

- 1) Maybe you're viewing it from cache? (disable joomla and fb (if exists) cache and empty your browser cache (better, use another browser you never used to surf your site).
- 2) There's another place where to make this (or similar) mod, I'd make a bit of debug simply creating a sort of 'marker' to have a way to understand where is the code that generate that image. Once you found the place, play a bit with the code.

I changed the code, but nothing happens. So I searched the gifs and found the avatar-collection in joomla/images/comprofiler.

The working animated gif is named 79_49072235e3e7e.gif - the non-working animated gif is called tn79_49072235e3e7e.gif. This Thumbnail was made by the "system".

What should I do now? Rename the tn-xxx.gif?
