Installed the joomap plugin and immediately got several php errors and notices in my error logs on the server. Took only a few days until googlebot started complaining about invalid links.

Turns out there are two 'bugs' in the plugin:

1.) The 'hidden' poweredby link in the google sitemap refers to a mos variable that can't be referenced inside the module. Also the external link provided to the google sitemap causes googlebot to complain.
solution: simple - take out the poweredby link

2.) The sql to retrieve the fireboard threads is incomplete. The column 'time' does not get named, causing the code to throw an error a few lines down when forum->modified is being accessed.
solution: name the 'time' column as 'modified' within the sql

With these two changes the plugin actually works.

Attached is the modified file. Download and rename it to joomap.fireboard.php and replace the original one with it.

Hope this helps!
