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It's in the CB package that you downloaded. I don't think it would be provided if you weren't supposed to use it with CB. Maybe you should check the install instructions and also visit the Joomlopolis forums since I'm not a CB "expert". On the sites I install CB I also use the cblogin module instead of the "stock" Joomla one for full compatibility.

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
