You need to go to the admin back-end of Joomla (it's Joomla by the way not Joomla!)

Then at the top where it says Menus go to Main Menu, or whichever menu you want to add the link to.

Then go to New.

You'll see a list of different components and somewhere in that list you will see FireBoard (OMG YAY!)

Click it! :woohoo:

Fill out the title, alias and other fields. Make sure you tick the published button.

Then click save!

Test it out in the front end.
