As such many promised items, such as group access and forum converters, did not make it into this release. New features will not be added anytime soon much less integration with other components/modules. No need to ask the dev team. They have already stated as much.

Also my statement about them running JOOMLABOARD was meant to highlight the fact that they seem to have no intention of supporting Fireboard truly, or realize that Fireboard is in no state, at the present, to be integrated with other components/modules.
