I've looking around this days and try to realize how to use jQuery library.  
Now i know, that this is not so hard.

You have to go through next steps:

1. Download jquery library and include it in your template index.php
2. Put these lines in HEAD section (you can change values for css)

```
$(document).ready(function(){
  $("dd:not(:first)Â«Â»).hide();
  $("dt a"Â«Â»).click(function(){
    $("dd:visible"Â«Â»).slideUp("slow"Â«Â»);
    $(this).parent().next().slideDown("fast"Â«Â»);
    return false;
  });
});
```

dl,dd { margin: 0; }
dt { background: #FF3; font-size: 1.2em; padding: 5px; margin: 2px; }
dt a { color: #FFF; }
dd a { color: #555; }
ul { list-style: none; padding: 5px; }
