Hey All,

Due to many requests from our passionate users :kiss: here is a nightly build from our latest SVN.

Terms:

- This is a nightly build. should not be used on a production site. of course you can use it with your responsibility :silly:
Overall I can tell it is better than 1.0.0 version as many improvements over the code has been done, but may contain new bugs, as this is work in progress. so just use it for your tests

- Backup your files and database!! Did I tell you to backup? YES! specially your template folder, uploaded folder and avatars, as all your files will be deleted!!!

1) If you dont want to deal with directory backups,... just overwrite the files over the current ones.

2) Otherwise

- Uninstall fireboard
- Reinstall it

Now:

-
- Run the SQL upgrades
 - In case you have done 2, put back your old directories in place (uploaded, avatar, template)

That's all.

Download it here New release overrides this nightly build. please use 1.0.1
